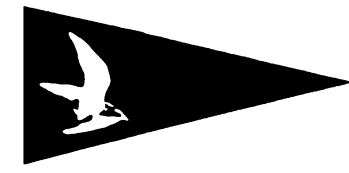
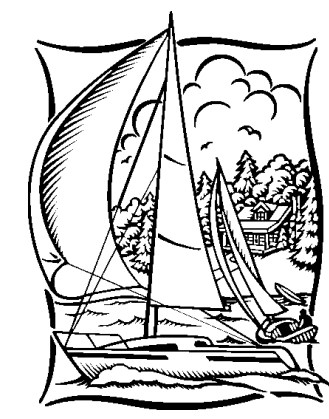

NOTICE

All those taking part in the Regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Organizing Authority or any party involved with the organization of the event disclaim any and every responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and at sea as a consequence of participation in the event covered by these sailing instructions. Attention is drawn to ISAF Fundamental Rule 4: Decisions to Race. A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing.

RULES

This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the national authority when they apply, the sailing instructions and any other applicable rules.

EQUIPMENT

The owner/skipper is responsible to see that his vessel is properly equipped for offshore racing. Attention is called to Fundamental Rule 1.2: a boat shall carry adequate lifesaving equipment for all persons on board, including one item ready for immediate use, unless class rules make some other provision. Each competitor is individually responsible for wearing personal buoyancy adequate for the conditions.

CREW

Not less than three --- no maximum.

RACING

Classes

The Organizing Authority will divide the fleet into appropriate classes based on ratings. There will be two starts. ARC and JAM will start first followed by PHRF.

THE START

The starting line will be between a staff displaying a Race Committee

flag on the Race Committee boat and a HISC marker. The line will be approximately 1 mile North of the Hillsboro Inlet and approximately 200 yards off the shore line.

RECALL

Individual recalls shall be signaled by displaying flag X in accordance with rule 29.2. A general recall shall be signaled by displaying flag First Substitute in accordance with rule 29.3.

POSTPONE AND ABANDON

Before the starting signal the Race Committee may postpone by displaying flag AP or abandon the race by displaying flag N over H or A for any reason. The flag may be displayed onshore or on the committee boat. If a boat abandons the race, it must notify the Race Committee at Old Port Yacht Club, telephone (561) 626-2280 ASAP. COURSE AND MARKS

From the starting line boats will proceed to the finish line which will be North of the Lake Worth inlet approximately 100 yards north of the pumping station. The line will be between the No. 2 Buoy (red flashing 4 sec.) approximately .5 miles off shore and the Beach Committee flag onshore. (Please note the Lake Worth Inlet has a #1 Sea Buoy located approximately 1 mile off shore in 90 feet of water;
